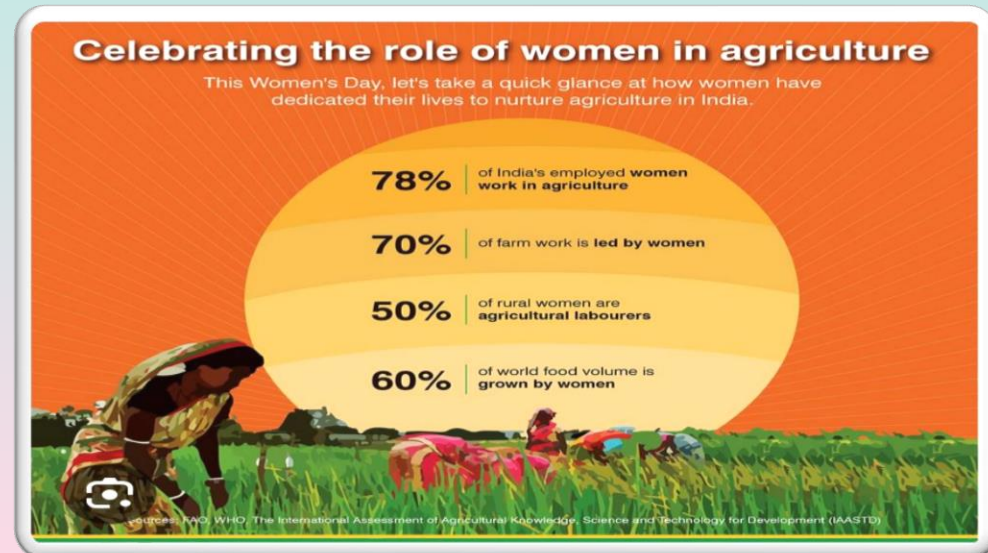
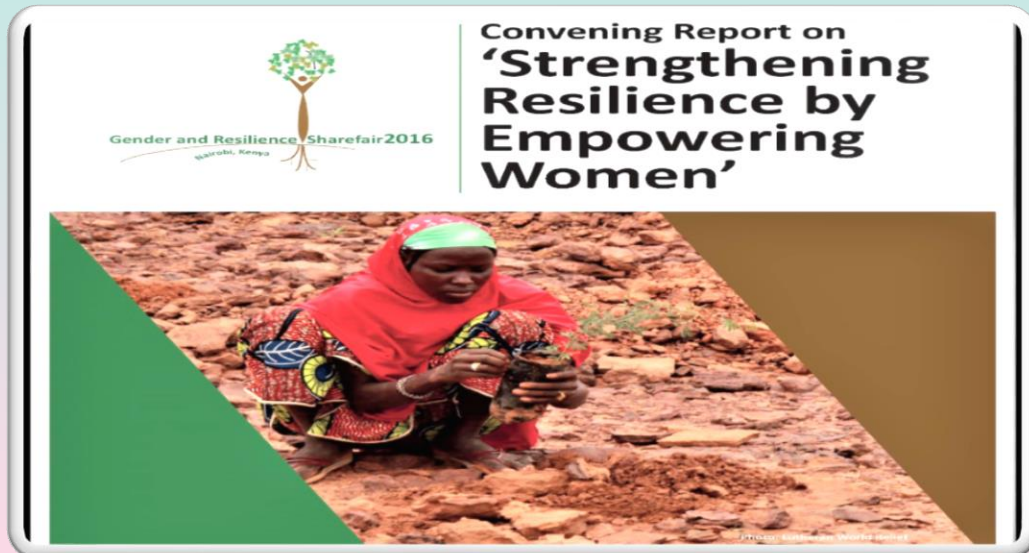
Role of Women in Agricultural Water Management

- ❖ Their contributions are integral to ensuring food security and environmental preservation. In particular, women-led water conservation techniques is vital for sustainable farming practices.



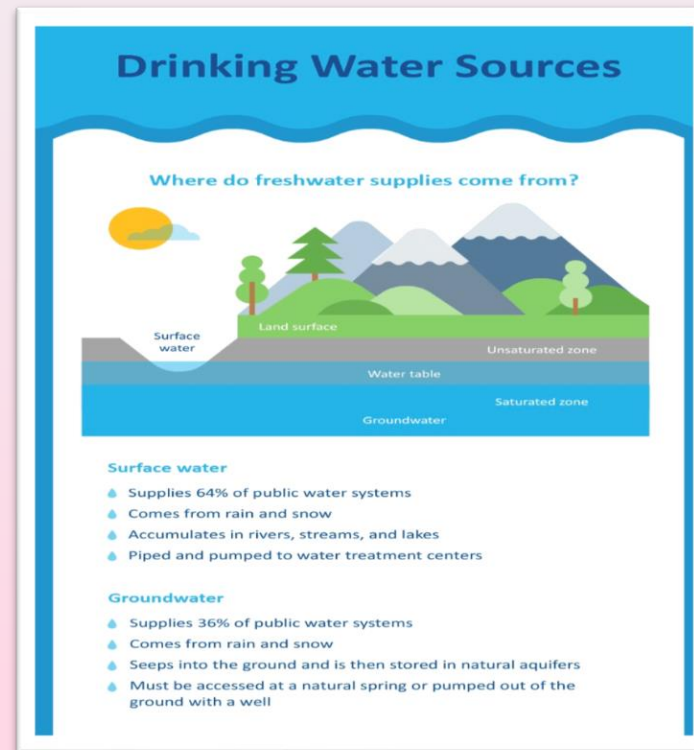
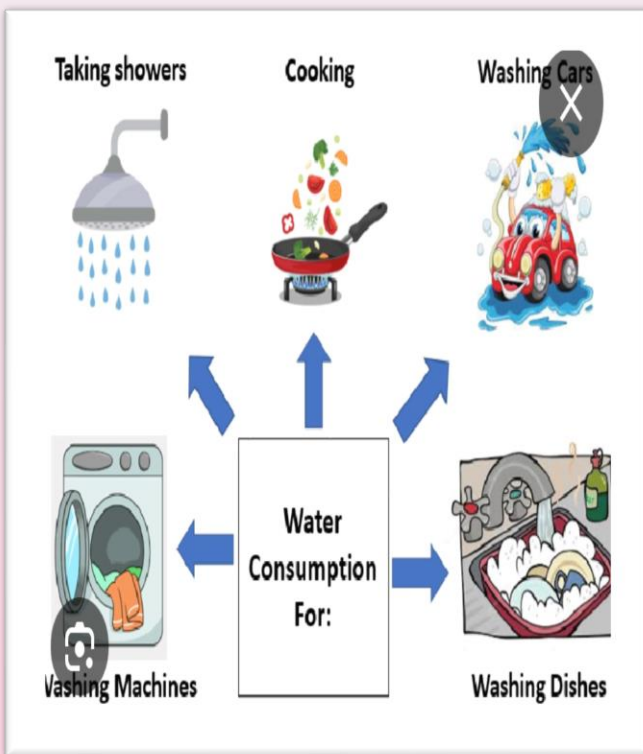
Role of Women in Agricultural Water Management

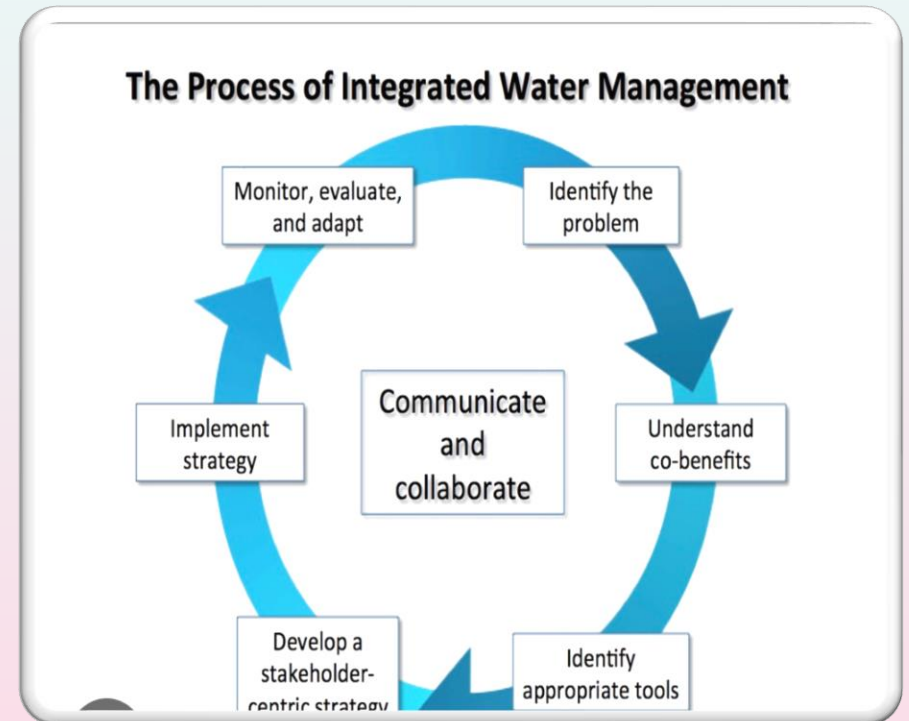

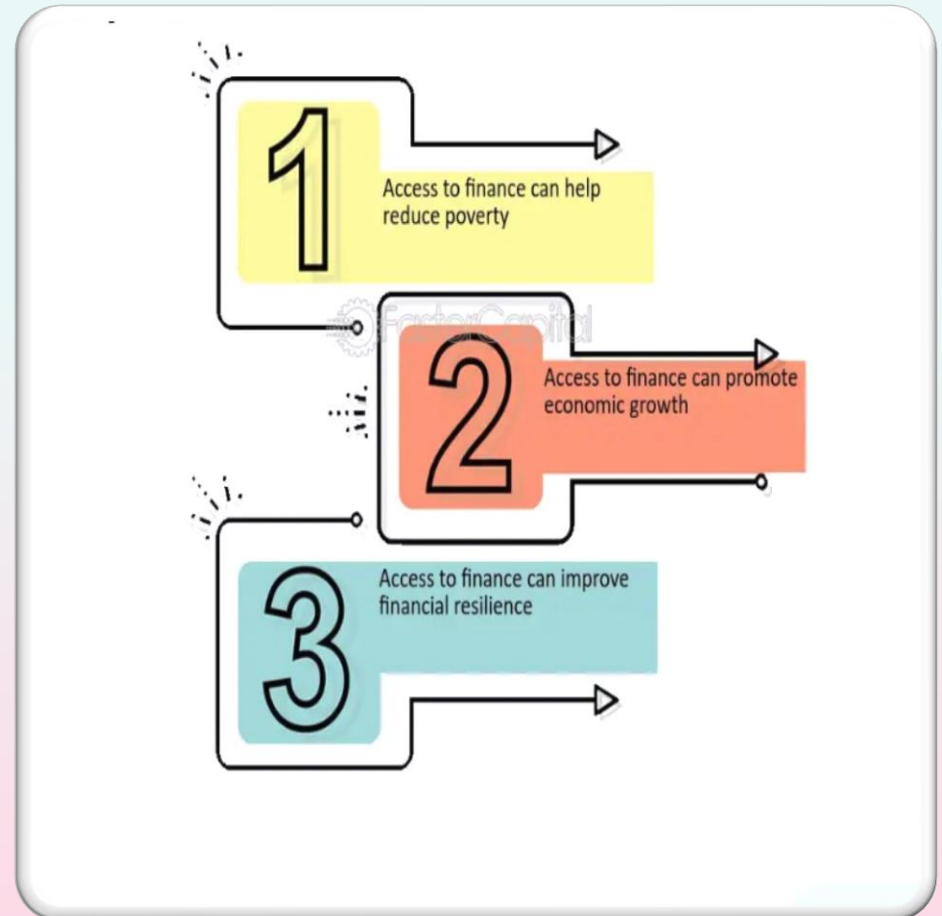

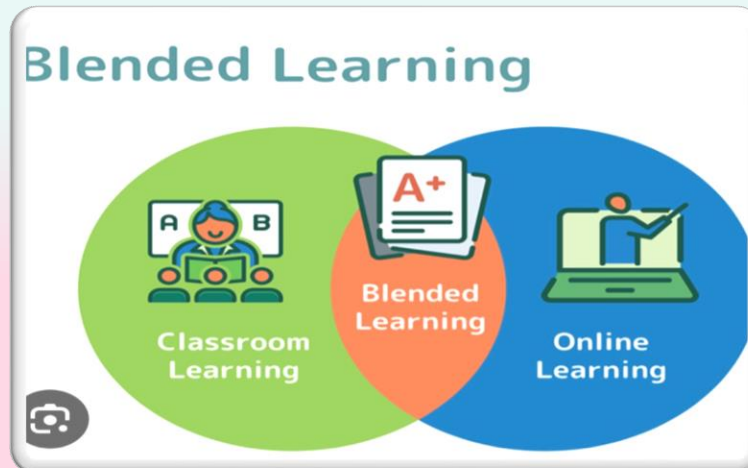
